



EQUIPMENT LIST – MA / MFA Acting International

The following list is intended to give you some guidance around how best to equip yourself to participate in a range of classes and activities. Costs listed below are indicative based on our research, however it is suggested that you shop around to find the most cost-effective option.

For skills and acting classes		Approx. cost
1.	At least two pairs of jazz / yoga pants / leggings (black cotton / lycra mix) - these or equivalent items will be needed during week 2	£17 (per item)
2.	At least two tops (two close fitting black t-shirts), leotard not necessary – no logos	£10 (per item)
3.	Tight fitting underwear/sports bra suitable for movement	£13
4.	One mobile phone that can be used for sound recording and phrasing (if you already own a smartphone you will have or can download an app that enables capture of sound)	Access to smartphone with app
5.	A way to hold hair away from your face (hairband)	£2
6.	Kneepads	£14
7.	Yoga mat (thin with grip)	£12

1.	Travel to and from Globe Residency. Depending on where you live while at East 15, the travel to and from East 15 to the Globe theatre will be £40-50 per week. The residency is three weeks We would advise to put money aside for this	£120-£150
2	MFA Second Year only. Travel to and from London venues in second year	£80
3.	In preparation for Voice work, we suggest you source a copy of Voice into Acting by Christina Gutekunst and John Gillett. This publication is available in the library, although copies are limited and students find it useful to be able to annotate texts.	£22
4	We suggest you put some funds aside each year to pay for theatre trips and small course-related expenses.	£100
5	Scripts- these are not bought by East 15. But most can be obtained second hand from Amazon, World of Books etc.	£60
